Long Protocol IVF/ICSI at a glance

Prior to your treatment start date, an appointment will be arranged with a fertility nurse to explain and discuss all aspects of your treatment, and to complete all of the relevant consents forms required. This will take approximately 1-2 hours, and you will need to attend with your partner (if appropriate). Payment will be taken prior to this appointment, for fee paying cycles. Any outstanding investigations will be arranged.

Day 1- 3 of cycle

Please contact Yorkshire Fertility for appointment 7 days after ovulation (approximately day 21 of the cycle). Your blood tests for infection screening **MUST** but available and in date prior to starting, so please arrange prior to next appointment.

You will need to collect all prescribed medication from the pharmacy at Calderdale Royal Hospital prior to attending, and bring to your next appointment. Please contact them to confirm that the prescription is ready to be collected on:

NB. Some medication will need to be stored in the fridge, so please ensure you check the items and store appropriately.

Please abstain from sexual intercourse or use a barrier form of contraception from day 1 of your cycle until at least 1 week post egg collection.

Day 21 Appointment

Ultrasound scan performed and screening bloods checked.

If appropriate, you will be advised when and how to start the Buserelin injections and the dose prescribed. This should be taken in the evening, at the same time every day.

2-3 weeks later: Appointment for scan

Usually a Thursday or Friday (you will have had a period since last visit). In some instances, you may not be ready to move on to the next stage of treatment at this scan. This is not uncommon, and we may need to rescan you the following week. Start 2nd injections if screening bloods ok, on the Friday (instructions given).

Appointment for day 6 of stimulation

Not required for every patient. Scan to assess recruitment and size of follicles. Bring all medication, except the Ovitrelle injection, with you to this appointment.

Appointment for day 7-9 of stimulation

Scan to assess recruitment and size of follicles. Bring all remaining medication to this appointment, except the Ovitrelle.

Further appointments

It is common to require further scans to monitor the growth and development of follicles. You may require further prescriptions depending on the duration of treatment.

When follicles are mature

The egg collection will be arranged at the appropriate time by the staff and instructions will be given verbally and in writing regarding the late-night injection (Ovitrelle). The egg collection will be approximately 36 hours after this injection.

Embryo transfer will be arranged between you and the central unit and is typically 3-5 days following egg collection.

2 days after egg collection

You will start the progesterone medication – usually cyclogest pessaries used at night. The Yorkshire Fertility team will confirm the dose that you have been prescribed.

There are some occasions where cycles do not reach the pregnancy test stage or treatment. If this happens, the medical staff will advise you further about your amended treatment plan.

14-17 days after egg collection an appointment will be made to attend for pregnancy test (blood sample).

The nurse will arrange contact with you the same day to give you your result. If positive a scan will be arranged for 2 weeks later. If negative, follow up appointment will be arranged 4-6 weeks later.

Please be aware in some instances the blood test may need to be repeated.
